\$100,000 RAISED FOR WATER PROJECTS

We are so thrilled to announce that our church partners across the country have raised over **\$100,000 for water projects** through Global 6K events! 6 kilometres marks the average distance people in developing countries, often women and children, have to walk to reach a water source. A water source which is often dirty and will make them sick.

With this money raised, we can supply safe, clean water to communities that will significantly change their lives – clean water they can drink, cook, and wash with means they can be healthier. Less time walking for water means more children can attend school and work towards a brighter future.

Throughout May and June, we saw support from **11 churches, from Green Timbers Covenant Church in British Columbia to Clarendville Connect in Newfoundland, we had coast-to-coast coverage of Global 6K events which continues to grow in momentum. A MONUMENTAL WIN

After more than 10 years of advocacy work, the Canadian Government has passed into law Bill S-211, the Fighting Against Forced Labour and Child Labour in Supply Chains Act.

This landmark legislation will help combat forced labour and child labour in Canadian supply chains, requiring companies to be transparent about their efforts to prevent and mitigate the risks of child and forced labour in their operations abroad. Bill S-211 will enable Canadians to have more confidence that their purchases are ethical.

RESULTS AND IMPACT

Our annual report which details our work in 2022 including our impacts and strategic approach.

2022 snapshot:

- 13 million people were reached through 299 programs.
- 44% of our program funding was invested in the most fragile countries.
- We responded to 27 emergencies in 29 countries reaching 4.8 million people.
- 10,841 deaths were prevented over the past three years through our work with the World Food Programme.
